International Tonga Mission Trip 2019

All students and adults going to the mission trip need to be at the Alaska Airline in San Francisco airport (domestic terminal) by 1:00 PM on Tuesday, March 19th. Detailed itinerary is included in the packet handed out by Mr. Hicks at the last meeting. This mission is to help the Beulan Adventist college (high school) with remodeling projects and providing dental and medical services to the people in the community. The mission trip is from March 19-31.

Third Quarter Ends March 22

Community Service Day (Regular School Day) Friday, March 22


Dear Friend,
