Attendance and Class Participation: Student attendance will be taken on a daily basis by teachers during the live instruction portion of classes online. Teachers will check for student participation in daily live instruction via Zoom/Hangouts. If students are unable to participate in live instruction, please contact the teacher directly, prior to the live meeting.



Grades: Grades will continue to be letter-based using A through F marks for the 2020-2021 school year.



Communication: Students will need to take ownership of their education in this new environment. As they learn to do this, they will need to monitor their MVA student Gmail account and Google Classroom for information on their assignments, meeting times and links to log in, and to stay up-to-date on teacher expectations for their classes.



Video Conferencing Norms for Students:

- Do not share class Zoom/Google Hangouts information with others. The teacher will only admit students registered to the class.
- Students must use their MVA Gmail account and their own full name (First and Last)
- Students cameras should be turned on most of the time or as specified by the teacher. If you or your parent/guardian has privacy concerns, please communicate those with your teachers.
- Student should make sure their clothes/background are appropriate. Please note when the camera is on, anything in your surroundings can be seen by classmates and the teacher.
- Be aware, teachers may be recording class instructional sessions for student reference. These videos will only be posted within our MVA Domain.

Acting inappropriate during the video conference includes, but is not limited to:

- Being disruptive, interrupting the speaker
- Using video inappropriately
- Being verbally inappropriate or using the chat inappropriately
- Posting inappropriate text or images
- Posting or streaming any content, texts or images from any class sessions on or through any social media/technology platform.

Teachers may engage in one or more of the following consequences:

- Muting and/or turning off the camera of the student during the video conference session.
- Following up to communicate individually with the students about their behavior.
- Temporarily removing a student from a video conference session for the day.
- Contacting the student's parent/guardian.
- Seeking additional restorative practices to support or disciplinary action from school administration.
