RETURN DEADLINE: MARCH 10!

Dear MVA Parent/Guardian,

MVA's Spring vacation is just weeks away. Though the usual sports events of the year are completed, the rest of the year will melt away very fast with the spring events such as field trips, tours, etc.. Students on this year's MVA Uruguay mission trip (Mar. 16-28) will be involved in another international community service event, and we wish them God's blessing and safe travel.

Thursday, March 17, is considered a minimum school day, with school concluding at 12 noon. MVA students and staff will participate in a community service day that Thursday. Adventist Christian schools require 25 hours of community service each year a student is in attendance. To help students meet this obligation, we have scheduled a four hour Thursday morning community service day that includes work assignments planned throughout the area, including Shoreline Park at the end of Shoreline Blvd. (at the north end of the Shoreline Blvd (one of the cross streets for MVA location), and McKelvey Park on Miramonte Ave. (just south of El Camino in Mountain View). A small group will be working at the Sunnyvale Adventist Church, and possibly several other locations close to the school campus.

Thank you for completing the attached required Volunteer Permission Letter/form. Remember, the form **REQUIRES BOTH STUDENT AND PARENT** information and signatures. Please call the office if you have any questions. **ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO PARTICIPATE – SINCE THIS IS CONSIDERED A SCHOOL DAY**. Work clothes that meet the Christian modesty test, are appropriate for the work day (loose fitting jeans, or shorts with a length that are within a few inches of the knees). All clothes must be in good repair. Tight or short t-shirts are NOT ACCEPTABLE. SLEEVELESS OR TANK TOPS/BASKETBALL JERSEY style shirts are not acceptable). T-shirts must be waist length and completely cover the midriff area.

Please call the office if you have any questions. Don't forget the return by the **March 10 deadline!** **STUDENTS MAY SIGN UP FOR THE WORK AREA OF THEIR CHOICE WHEN THE PERMISSION FORM IS COMPLETED AND RETURNED TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE.**

VOLUNTARY ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

The City of Mountain View is willing to allow me onto City property if I agree to the following conditions: I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims for death, personal injury, or property damage against the City of Mountain View, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers that I may sustain or may accrue as a result of my presence on and travel to and from City property. I understand and agree that this waiver and release includes claims or damages caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the City, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers.

In addition, I agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City, its officers, officials, employees and volunteers from any and all liabilities for claims, loss, demands, injury or damages or actions that arise out of or relate to my participation of the work / educational project on my own behalf or on behalf of a client.

I also agree that in the event of a loss due to my operation and completion of the project I shall look solely to my own insurance coverage for recovery. My insurance coverage is primary and non-contributory. I agree to a waiver of any right to subrogation which any such insurer I may have contracted with against the City by virtue of the payment of any loss under such insurance.

I have carefully read this release form and I fully understand the terms used in it and their legal significance. I understand that this Release is a legally binding contract between the City and me. I am fully competent to enter this release. If you are a minor a parent/guardian signature is required. No oral representations or inducements have been made to me to sign this Release. I understand that while working on this project I am not an agent of the City.
